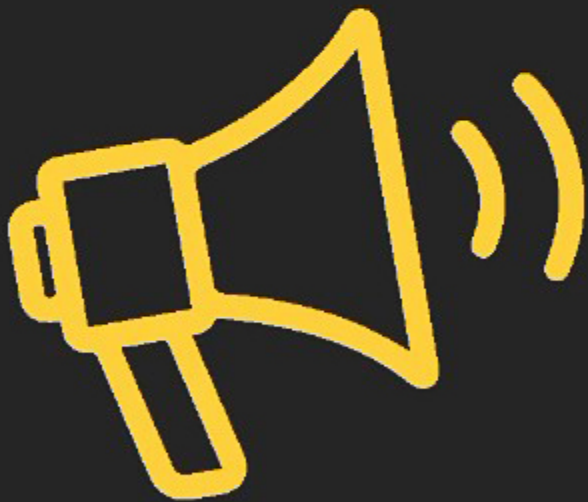

JEAN DE LA FONTAINE



Born: 8th July 1621 (Chateau-Thierry, France)
Died: 13th April 1695 (Paris, France)
Marriage: Marie Hincart (1647-1695)
He is known for his fable works. He was the child of a wealthy family. He studied law in a college in Paris. A priest was asked to be raised. He left the church in high school. He couldn't be a successful student in school life. In his youth, he was engaged in forest and water canals, which was his father's profession. He worked in various civil servants and lived an irregular life. He died in Paris on 13th April 1695.

ABOUT HIS FABLES

La Fontaine gave moral characters to animals in style of Dede Korkut tales in the tales he wrote, criticizing some human characters in their characters and gave a moral lesson. This is called the art of diagnosis and insight in literature. This feature of La Fontaine was seen in his late simplicity and clarity are seen in French works. He brought great works in the form of literature with his fluent poems in the form of speech, his criticisms on animals and his methods of sarcasm without hurting.

The subjects in the tales of La Fontaine are taken from the oriental classics. Eighteen of the stories in Beydeba's *La Fontaine* and *Dieme*, written long before La Fontaine repeated in the form of poetry by this French man of letters. His tales are mostly written in a way that anyone can understand. La Fontaine has a lively, fast, graceful and witty narrative. Although he almost always chooses his characters from among animals, he sometimes involves people, especially villagers. The animals he often refers to are the lion, the wolf, the fox, the donkey and the rooster.

La Fontaine tried to explain what is good by showing the bad. However, it is a fact that the opposite effect occurs if no explanation is made for children who read their poems.

His tales are 238 in total and are collected in 12 books. There are 124 fables in his first six books, published in 1668 and these make up the first volume. The second volume consist of five books published in 1678. The third volume, which was last published in 1694, consists of a single book.

When asked if you had one more chance, would you pick up bad habits again, 64 Percent of those who answered yes to question 1 said yes.

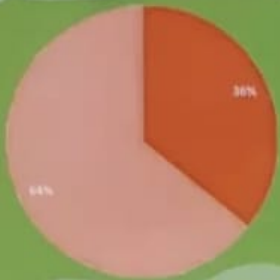

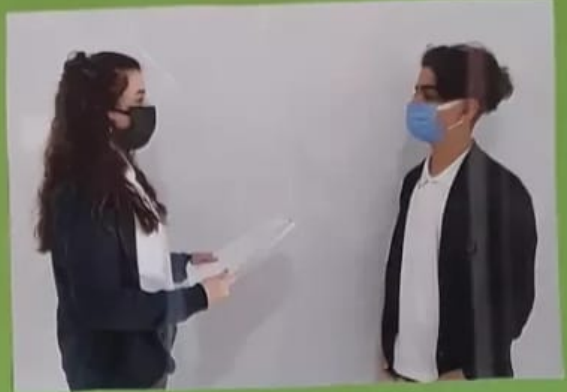
Peer-Pressure Survey Analysis

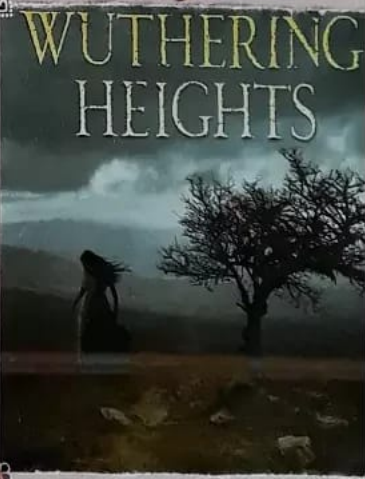
